Award in Leadership and Management

This qualification is ideal if you are a new, existing or aspiring manager who has no formal training, but is serious about developing and reflecting on the skills and knowledge needed to lead, organise and motivate teams in your work place, cadet unit or youth organisation.

What will I learn?

- How to solve problems and make informed decisions
- How to plan and conduct a briefing or presentation
- How different leadership styles impact you, and your team's behaviour
- How effective communication can be used to motivate your team

How is the course delivered and assessed?

The length of the course will depend on our delivery partner running the course. It should take approximately 40 hours to deliver the taught content and to prepare and submit the two written assignments for assessment by Cadet Vocational College. These will be based on your responsibilities in either your workplace, cadet unit or youth organisation.

If you are considering going to university or college it is perhaps worth knowing that this ILM Level 3 qualification, awarded by City & Guilds, attracts 8 UCAS points.

Entry requirements

To enrol, you must be aged 16 or over, a UK resident for three years, and have ideally achieved an English GSCE at Grade 4 (C) or equivalent. You must also be in a position where you are responsible for leading or managing others.

How will I be supported?

You will be supported by our delivery partner together with our Teaching and Learning team at Cadet Vocational College.

You can enrol and achieve this qualification at any time during the year.
