# BTEC Level 2 in Fire and Rescue Services in the Community

Whether you're considering going to college, university, or starting your career - perhaps in the Fire and Rescue Service - one thing is for certain: the more qualifications you have, the better your chances of success.

## What is it and what will I learn?

This qualification is available to members of the UK Fire Cadets only and has been developed in collaboration with the National Fire Chiefs Council (NFCC). It aligns with the Fire Cadets National Syllabus (Awards 1 and 2) to ensure a consistent and meaningful learning experience. Learners will explore key topics including teamwork and leadership within the Fire and Rescue Service and wider emergency services, career pathways in the sector; the role of Fire and Rescue in supporting local communities, and casualty extrication techniques used in real-life scenarios.

## How long will it take to complete?

The qualification is designed with flexibility in mind, enabling your child to complete it at their own pace alongside school and other commitments. It is delivered by adult instructors within their UK Fire Cadet unit and completed using paper-based workbooks.

## Why is it worth the time and effort?

Your child will gain a recognised qualification that strengthens their CV and helps them stand out when applying for college, university, apprenticeships, employment, or a future career in the Fire and Rescue Service. It demonstrates that they've developed key employability skills highly valued by both employers and educators.

## Will they receive support?

Yes – we work in close partnership with the National Fire Chiefs Council (NFCC) to ensure that trusted adult instructors within the UK Fire Cadets organisation support your child at every stage of the qualification. Your involvement is equally important. By encouraging their progress, supporting time management, and checking in regularly, you can play a key role in helping them stay motivated and succeed.
